



### Waddington All Saints Academy School Uniform Policy

Our Academy has high expectations of itself and its pupils. We endeavour to achieve the best that we can and demonstrate care, pride and quality in our work and outcomes. It is an expectation that pupils will positively represent the Academy and the wider Multi Academy Trust by looking smart, well presented and proud. Uniform plays a big part in securing this and the LEAD Behaviour Policy expects pupils choosing to attend a LEAD Academy to wear the full Academy uniform.

It is also recognised that within the community that we serve, many of our pupils come from a Service Family background where uniform has great significance.

Children should **always** wear an Academy logo when on visits out of school, so that they are easily identified from other children in red tops. It is also an expectation that when children have the opportunity to represent the Academy, in or out of school, they will be in full uniform.

All items of clothing must be named, so that they can be returned if lost. We do not have the capacity to store unnamed lost property.

#### **Waddington All Saints Academy Uniform**

- **Red sweatshirt /cardigan** with the Waddington All Saints Academy logo
- **White** shirt/polo T-shirt (available with the Academy logo if desired)
- **Grey or black** trousers/shorts/skirt/pinafore or red and white gingham dress (not leggings)
- Plain **black shoes** or plain **black leather ankle boots** - no trainers allowed (footwear **must** be smart / no higher than the ankle / low heel / no decoration and closed toe)

#### **P.E. Clothing**

*All pupils should have the following in the Academy for competition and Physical Education:*

- Black shorts (for indoor and outdoor use)
- A white round neck T shirt (also available with the Academy logo)
- Plain black jumper / fleece
- Black tracksuit bottoms (for use outdoors only)
- Plimsolls/trainers

P.E. clothing should be kept in a draw-string bag and kept in the Academy **at all times**, taking them home at the end of the half term or when they need to be washed.

#### **Jewellery**

Pupils should not have jewellery, such as bracelets, necklaces or rings, on show in the Academy for health and safety reasons. Stud earrings and watches may be worn but must be removed for all PE lessons.

#### **Cost**

The Academy has ensured that the uniform is available at a modest cost that should not be prohibitive to our families. **Financial support is available** under certain circumstances and any financial difficulty preventing compliance with full uniform should be discussed with the Academy.

The current cost of the Academy uniform available from Uniform Direct is:

- Sweatshirt or Cardigan with logo £6 to £12
- Also available: Polo shirts and PE shirts between £4 and £7, PE bag £3, black shorts £3.
