## The River that Flows Beside Me

### How do we protect the stories of our rivers?

Becoming River Restoration Officers, we will learn all about rivers to raise awareness for key organisations, who protect the UK waterways.. We learn what part rivers play in the life stories of all living things to inform our parents and the local MP of the importance of protecting rivers.

As Geographers, we begin our journey by using Google Maps to explore the local rivers around us. before exploring rivers nationally and then world-wide. Using diagrams and key vocabulary, we investigate the features of rivers using the case study of the River Thames, building our understanding of how rivers form over three stages and how they shape the landscape on their journey from source to mouth. On this journey, we will make observations of how rivers are used, at different stages, and how this has changed over time. Building upon our understanding of the River Thames, we explore a significant river in Europe – The Danube River. We use a range of sources, including maps and case studies,

developing our understanding of the features of the Danube River and the role it plays in several European Nations. We will continue to explore how another area of the world uses rivers and how it impacts on the daily lives of settlements and communities in the country of Zambia. With a strong understanding of how rivers can impact humans, we focus on the cause and effect of humans using rivers – how rivers are impacted by us. To finish, we use our understanding of rivers to analyse the impacts of flooding and what can be done by humans to reduce risks and impact.

### Author Study


In our aim of developing a community of readers, reading and stories sit at the heart of everything that we do.
