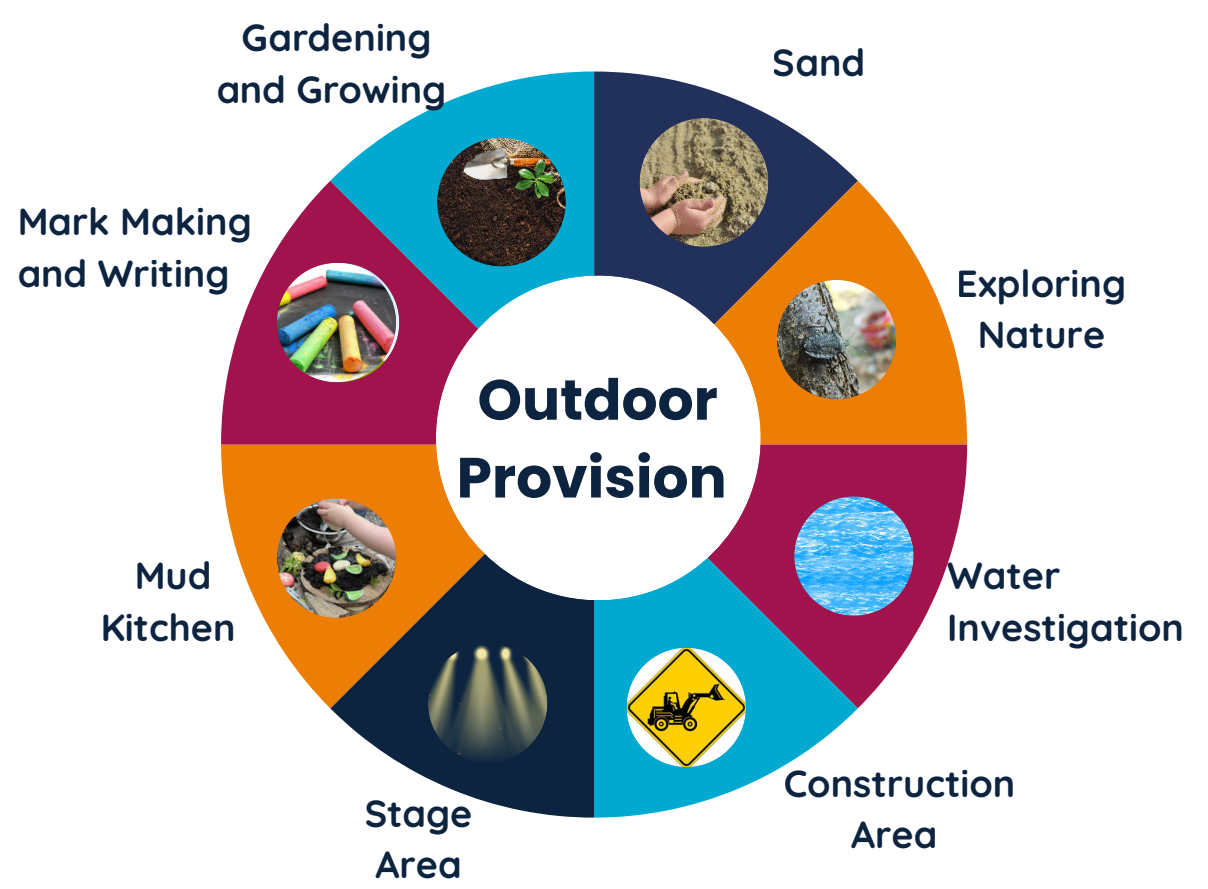




# Continuous Provision Map

Our learning environments play a key role in supporting and extending children's development. Continuous provision is the environment that has been created with defined spaces for children to use every day. This can be indoors or outdoors, with a range of purposeful resources that have been planned intentionally within each space to allow playing and exploring, active learning and creating and thinking critically.



**Playing and Exploring**  
Children investigate and experience things. They are willing to 'have a go'  
**Engagement**

Children concentrate and keep on trying when they encounter difficulties. They enjoy their achievements  
**Motivation**

**Creating and Thinking Critically**  
Children have and develop their own ideas. They make links between ideas and choose ways to do things
