- From birth to 5 years
- Children learn through playing and exploring, being active and creative and through critical thinking.
- Indoor and outdoor learning experiences
- ► Follow the children's interests and individual needs.

Tapestry is an online learning journal.

See what your child has been doing at school and share this with them at home.

The learning that your child produces at school will go into their 'learning profile'.

They are able to see progression in their learning across the year and work with an adult to decide their next steps.

Homework and Reading Books



A short homework task will be sent home each week, via Tapestry. This will mirror the phonics learning that the children are accessing in school







- The children will bring home a phonics reading book each week.
- This is the same book that they will read at school.
- These must be brought into school each day.
- Each child will also have a reading record for you to share your child's reading progress at home.
